Content and narrative are features of cultural output that were once considered necessary for such things as literature and academic theories. They are regarded by mediocracy as superfluous, and representative of elitism. Cultural output should leave the uninitiated helpless to make autonomous judgements without the assistance of socially accredited experts.

Mediocracy regards itself as representing the natural end product of civilisation. Hence there is no need for new ideas in philosophy, art, physics, etc., and these fields can be rebranded as social activities, intended primarily for the promotion of egalitarian values. All significant theoretical problems have been 'solved' – i.e. dismissed as meaningless.
